#### C. Visa on arrival for a maximum of 15 days

- 7. The requirements for a visa on arrival are as follows:
- The applicant must be in possession of a passport, valid for at least six months, and a valid return ticket, which is usable within 15 days from the date of entry;
- The applicant must fill out and submit an application form (TM.88) which is available at the Visa-on-Arrival counter at Suvarnabhumi Airport together with one recent passport-size photograph. There is an application fee of 1,000 Thai baht.

8. Participants from countries other than those listed above are requested to obtain an appropriate entry visa from the Thai diplomatic or consular mission at the point of origin or en route prior to entering Thailand.

The information provided above is accurate as at 26 August 2013. All participants are advised to consult with the diplomatic mission/embassy of Thailand in their respective countries regarding the latest applicable immigration requirements prior to their departure.

#### IV. Weather

9. In March the weather in Pattaya has been predicted to be hot and humid. The anticipated temperature is between 32 – 34 degrees Celsius. The meeting room where the meeting is to be held is airconditioned.

## VI. Foreign currency declaration

- 10. Any person who brings into or out of Thailand an aggregate amount of foreign currency exceeding US\$20,000 or its equivalent is required to declare the amount to a customs officer. Failure to do so, or making any false declaration to a customs officer, is a criminal offense.
- 11. The local currency is the Thai baht. Currency exchange facilities are available at the hotel's reception counter.

#### VII. General Information

#### 12. Electricity

The electricity voltage in Bangkok is 220V, 50Hz. Please note that plug adapters may be necessary. The plug in Thailand has not been standardized and the following types are available.



A standard grounded outlet supporting European 2-pin plugs and earthed and unearthed American plugs.



United States, Canada (NEMA 1-15; no ground pin; front tab is ground; 120 V; 10 and 15 A)
Japan, Taiwan, Province of China (100 V), China, Philippines (220 V)

#### 13. Water

Tap water in Bangkok is generally not suitable for drinking. It is better to drink bottled water or water provided by the hotel.

- Metered taxis are available at all times. Please be sure that the driver starts the meter when you enter the taxi (the fare begins at 35 baht). Please refer to paragraphs below for information on taxis from the airports.

### VIII. Airline reservations

15. Many international airlines operate regular services to and from Bangkok. Participants are advised to secure their return bookings prior to their departure for Bangkok. If this is not possible, they should make firm return bookings immediately upon arrival in Bangkok.

#### IX. Hotel accommodation

16. The Amari Pattaya is the designated hotel for the Expert Group Meeting. Please note that single rooms have been reserved for all participants from 3 to 5 March 2014 (3 nights). The rate for a single room inclusive of daily buffet breakfast, wireless Internet access, and government tax is at THB 3,300 baht (approximately LISD 100) per room per day.
