Government Response

A total number of 10,95,794 persons were evacuated to safe places



Early Warning Involvement of People



Government Protocol

- One day before cyclone protocol issued by Government that special attention be paid to pregnant women, elderly & disabled in preparedness

Right Steps

- Carers / family members be with them in the same shelter
- Keep disability certificates and medical reports safe
- Provide Assistive devices as soon as possible

Inclusiveness & Special Needs

- *The community & disabled experienced the first hand knowledge on the need of inclusive approach in disaster risk management process*

- 4.5%

GAPS: Parallel Process

- Government process inclusive built on DPO knowledge
- But Civil Society esp DPOs not included in evacuation process

No mechanism in place for DPO inclusion
