More than half of the population living with no electricity - live in Asia-Pacific

A staggering 72% of the world's population - who are dependent on traditional cooking fuels - reside in this region

- Access to electricity (on- and off-grid)
- Access to clean energy for heating and cooking
- Access to mechanical power
- 62 countries
- 54 projects
- Total value US\$ 1.2 billion

Promoting low emission and climate resilient urban and transport infrastructure



- Energy efficiency and conservation
- Low Carbon Sustainable urban and transport systems
- 44 countries
- 68 projects
- Total value US\$ 2.5 billion
- GEF TF Grant US\$ 252 million


