

Purpose of a regional framework

• Help Governments make an effective plan to establish a set of baseline data by 2017.

Year	Activities
2015	ESCAP will publish "Disability at a glance".
2016	The Commission at its 72 nd session will review progress in the implementation of the Incheon Strategy.
	A baseline survey for the Incheon Strategy Indicators will be conducted in 2016.
2017	Establish reliable baseline data for 62 Incheon Strategy Indicators

Overview of an ESCAP draft regional framework on developing an effective national action plan for IS indicators data collection

- Essential elements of a plan
 - A single mechanism/agency: primary responsibility
 - Ministries/agencies: responsible for collecting data for each indicators
 - Timeframe
 - Budget
 - Plan for capacity building, M&E

A single mechanism/agency: primary responsibility

- National coordination mechanism and NSOs
 - Establishment of a task force
- Working group
- Highest political support for the task
- Inclusivity: participation of DPOs, multi stakeholders
