







Five Major Challenges in Cross-border Paperless Trade*

- Use of Common International Standards
- Harmonization of different legal frameworks
- Capacity gaps among the parties
- Cooperation between public and private sectors
- Lack of coordination mechanism (intergovernmental)



Inherent Nature of Challenges in Paperless Trade across Borders


- People are free to move around within a country So is movement of commercial goods
 It is under a unitary legal and social framework
- People are NOT free to move across borders
 So is movement of commercial goods across borders
 It is under heterogeneous legal and social framework

⇒ Facilitation is needed


♦ Who does such facilitation to enable paperless trade to happen across borders? ⇒ <u>Intergovernmental</u>
