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Overall National Development Goals (cont')

- Emphasizing the quality and sustainability of growth, achieving the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) by 2015, and building primary foundations for the future industrialization and modernization of the country.
- Taking firm steps to graduate from Least Developed Country (LDC) status by 2020.
- Widening and deepening regional and international integration.
- Maintaining GDP growth at least at 8% per year and GDP per capita of USD 1,700 by 2015 (at current prices).



Overall Energy Development Goals or policies

1. Increase access to modern energy
2. Reduce the use of fossil fuel and traditional energy
3. Increase power export to the neighboring
4. Promote sustainability for hydropower development
5. Increase development of renewable energy
6. Promote Energy Conservation and Efficiency
7. Increase self sufficiency of energy supply.
8. Provide reliable, sufficient and reasonable-price energy to secure the socio-economic development targets.

Current rural electrification programs

1. On grid scheme

- EdL: Generation and transmission
- PPP: In-advanced investments
- IPP: Generation and transmission for local villages

2. Off grid scheme

- Small hydro by provinces
