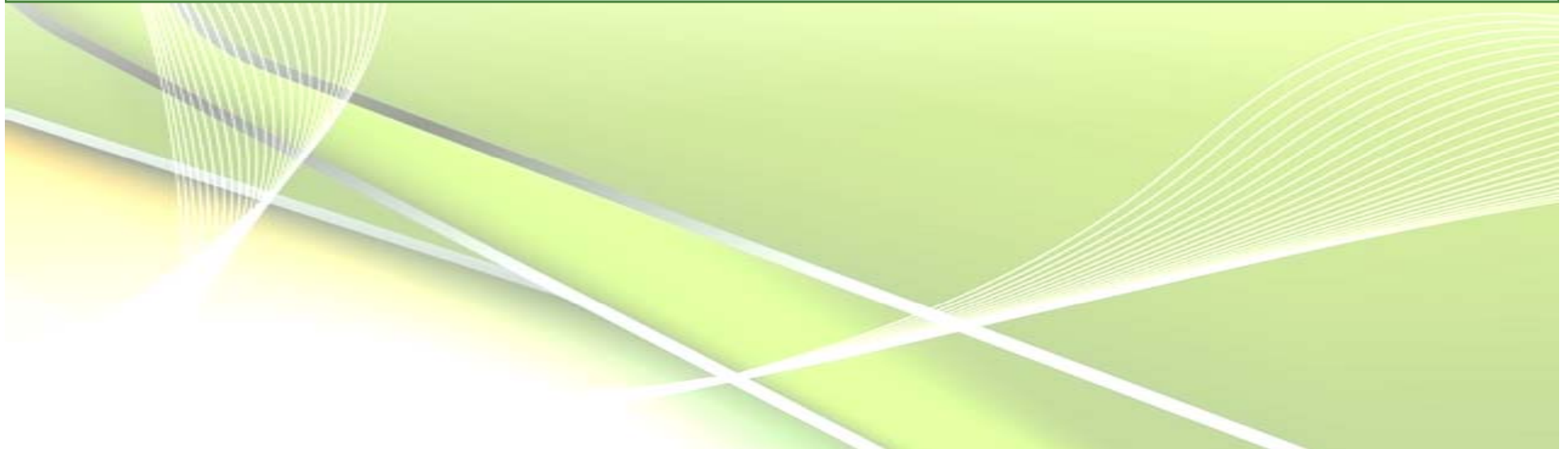

Information Technology Policy

- 1. Develop information technology infrastructure by accelerating the establishment of a hi-speed communications network that is broad based, accessible, adequate, reliable and reasonably priced, with fair competition.**
- 2. Promote free access to and appropriate use of the Internet in public areas and provide free Internet access in public areas.**
- 3. Promote the most effective use of frequencies.**
- 4. Promote the use of the public and private sector radio and television media, as well as conversion from analog to digital systems.**
- 5. Promote and support the development of software, hardware and related industries.**
