Overview of solid waste in the city

- Amount of waste: 60 - 65 tons/day

- Ratio of collection: 75 -80% (center area: 90%)

-Element of waste: 65% (organic), 35% (non-

organic)

- Establishing Steering Committee for implementation of pilot source separation at city level and mobilizing, propagandizing source separation at ward level.
- Coordinating with ENDA to provide training for Steering Committee and Advocacy Board.
- Involving study-tours among cities
- Introducing source separation program on mass media in the city and providing leaflet to people
