Global Plan for the Decade of Action

- Overall goal: to halt or reverse the increasing trend in road traffic fatalities around the world by increasing activities at the national level
- Global level: International coordination, strengthening global architecture for road safety
- National level (5 pillars): Road Safety Management, Safer roads and mobility, Safer vehicles, Safer road users, Post-crash response
- The Decade Global Plan Indicators: 29 core indicators, 15 optional indicators (total 44 indicators)



Revised Regional Indicators aligned with Global PoA

- Revised set of indicators: 36 indicators
 24 common indicators with the Global Plan indicators (17 core and 4 optional)
 12 indicators are of regional interests for example AH safety
- Require more frequent monitoring (serving our legislative meeting and reporting) → ESCAP collects road safety data from member States approximately every two years (in conjunction with the Road Safety EGM)
- Information provided by member States based on country status reports
