FACTS

- Out of total 26 million enterprises in India
 - > Total number of women enterprises (2010-11) is only 2.15 lakh (13.72%).
- Despite preferences in many schemes and other initiatives, very few Entrepreneurs are women

STEPS BY MSME MINISTRY, GOVT OF INDIA

In all the schemes of MSME Ministry, special dispensation for women.

Credit Assistance:

- Prime minister's Employment generation Programme
- Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS)
- Credit Guarantee Fund Scheme

Handholding Support:

Rajiv Gandhi Udyami Mitra Yojana (RGUMY)

Marketing and Technology Assistance:

 International Cooperation & Marketing Development Scheme

Dedicated programmes for women:

- TREAD
- Mahila Coir Yojna

PRIME MINISTER'S EMPLOYMENT GENERATION PROGRAMME AND WOMEN

- Subsidy of 35% of margin money in case of women entrepreneurs vis-à-vis 25% and less for other categories.
- In case of women entrepreneurs, beneficiary's contribution is 5 per cent of the project cost while in the case of others, it is 10 per cent of the project cost
- Bank finance in the form of loan is 95 per cent of the project cost in case of women whereas 90 per cent of the project cost in case of others.

CREDIT LINKED CAPITAL SUBSIDY SCHEME

- The scheme aims at facilitating technology upgradation by providing 15 per cent upfront capital subsidy
- In the scheme priority shall be given to Women entrepreneurs.

CREDIT GUARANTEE FUND SCHEME

- The guarantee cover available under the scheme is to the extent of 75 per cent of the sanctioned amount of the credit facility.
 - The extent of guarantee cover is 80 per cent for MSEs operated and/or owned by women;
 - As on 31st March 2010 Scheme benefited approximately 20.21 lakh persons. Of this, more than 80% are estimated to be women beneficiaries.

RAJIV GANDHI UDYAMI MITRA YOJANA (RGUMY)

The objective of RGUMY is to render hand-holding support and assistance to first generation entrepreneurs

- For urban women margin money subsidy is provided at the rate of 25% against 15%
 - For rural women it is 35% against 25%
