Way to go further

- Basic Infrastructure creates only "Interconnectivity" and that is only single dimension, but still need to further identify in some areas.
- To drive for the real Market Access can only be created by "Interoperability" by simplifying, harmonizing rules and regulations along the corridors.

1. Efficient Interoperability of cross border

- Physical Cross Border: Need to Know
 - Goods (what commodity/which volume/where to where)
 - Vehicles and equipments
 - Human (passengers/traders/transporter)
- Institutional Cross Border: Need to Agree

2. Identify high potential Corridors

- Identify domestic linkage between port, rail, road, inland waterway port and airport with Dry port in the member state
- Study, evaluate and analyze problem/constraint and opportunity in most high potential transport corridors in the region to create real economic corridors

3. Identify Multimodal Transport Corridors

- Identify relevant gateways/hub in member states
- Simplify customs procedure for mode-shift
- Identify place to make mode-shift
- Possibility using Dry Port

4. Connecting the economic development along the borders, set up production base.

- Government policy/Private Sectors Opportunity in setting up location of production base to connect with the border creating economic development in the corridors.
- Study goods flow and back haul system including using Dry Port/Warehouse as Distribution Center

5. Study on Benefit sharing in interconnectivity and interoperability among relevant member states

- Identify benefit of interconnectivity along the corridors
- Identify possibility of benefit sharing among relevant parties: how to share in win/win
