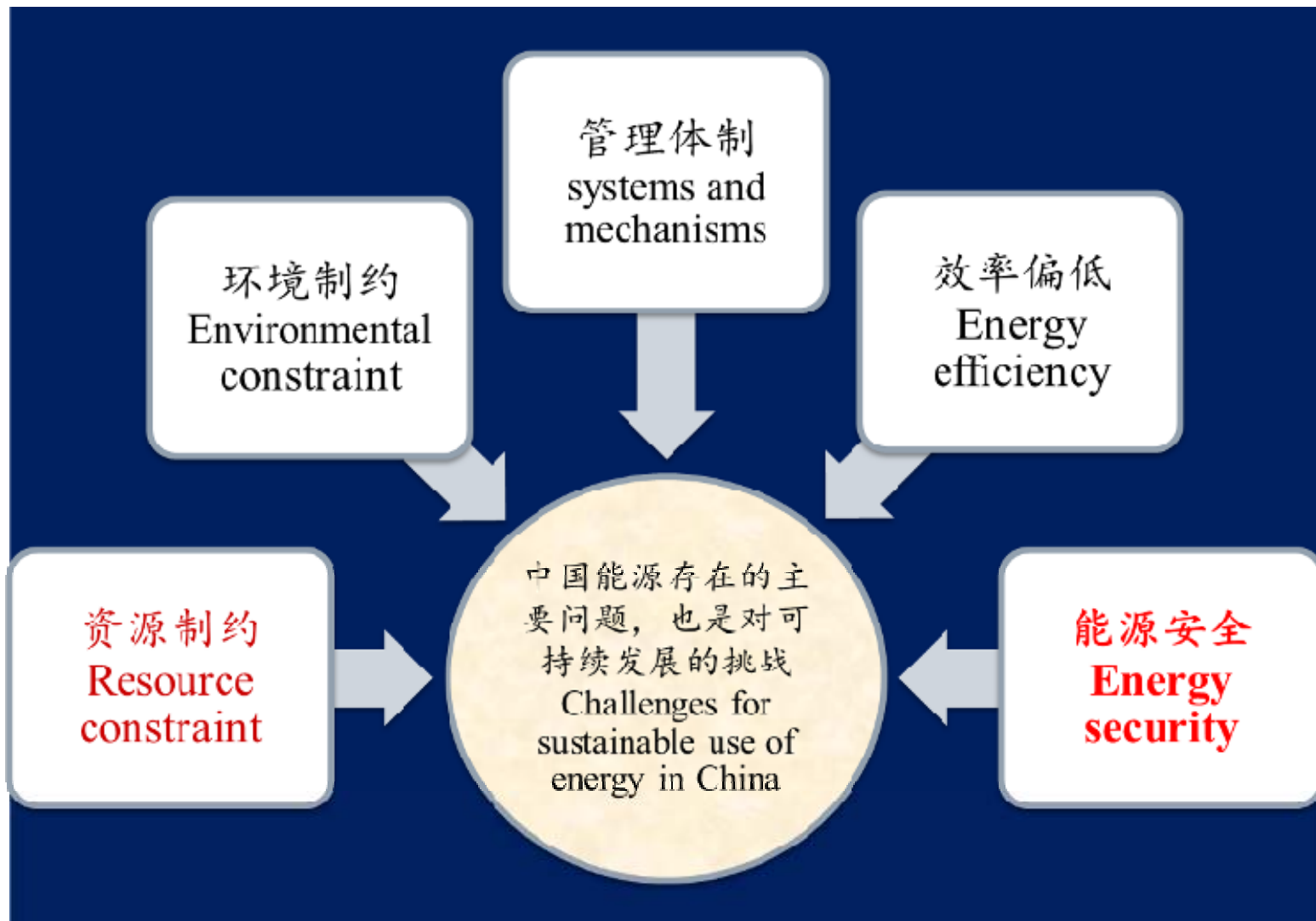

 - Sino-Russia, Sino-Mongolia; Sino-Japan, Sino-ROK
- Voice of China: "China shoulders a wide range of obligations and plays an active and constructive role in international energy cooperation."
- China's energy development has not only satisfied its own needs for economic and social progress, but also made great contributions to world's energy security and global market stability.
- Different countries should ensure mutually beneficial cooperation in international energy resources exploration, improve cooperation mechanisms, increase international energy supply and maintain market order
