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Nepal's vulnerability to natural hazards *The big picture ..*

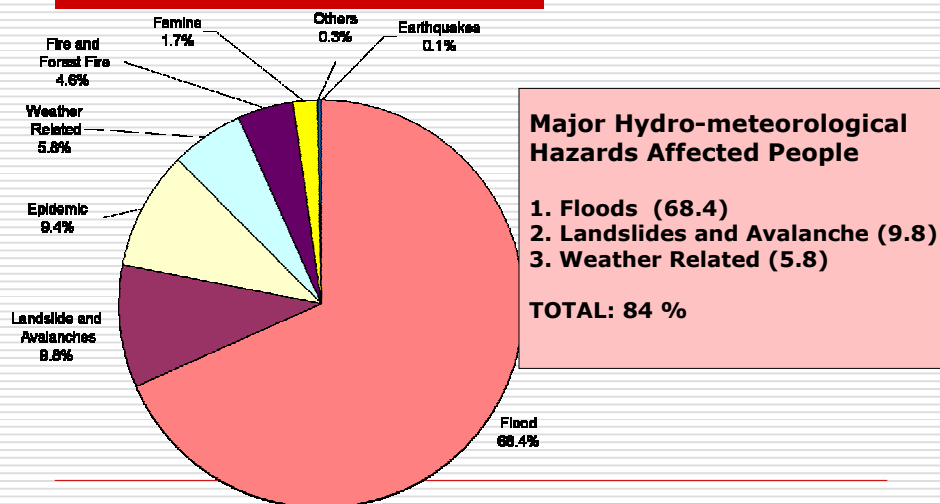
- **Natural Disasters Hot Spot** (world Bank 2005)

- 20th top most disaster prone country in the world
- 11th- Earthquake,
- 4th to climatic hazards
- 30th to Floods”

What have we achieved so far?

□ Post 1993:

- 1994 Nepal developed National Action Plan on DM and presented in the Yokohama Conference;
 - 1996 - Government endorsed the Plan;
 - Several I/NGOs, NRCS, etc. started DM activities;
 - UNDP initiated PDMP;
 - Large scale capacity development activities initiated;
 - IDNDR - 1990 - 1999/2000 - awareness raising activities
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What have we achieved so far?

□ Post 2000:

- NPC - 10th Five Year development Plan & 3 year plan
 - UNISDR - 2000 - awareness raising and capacity development activities
 - Nepal prepared a national position paper for the 2005 IInd WCDM
 - Re-thinking on our DM initiatives from post to pre-disaster
 - DRM in school curricula, risk transfer - insurance, CBDRM, EW, risk assessment, Department of Drug Control and DM,
 - National Strategy on DRM, DM Act,
 - Flagship initiative

CDRMP - Introduction

The Comprehensive Disaster Risk Management Programme (CDRMP) builds on the UNDP's long history of supporting the Government of Nepal in its efforts to manage disaster risks.

The CDRMP has been developed to support implementation of National Strategy for Disaster Risk Management (NSDRM).

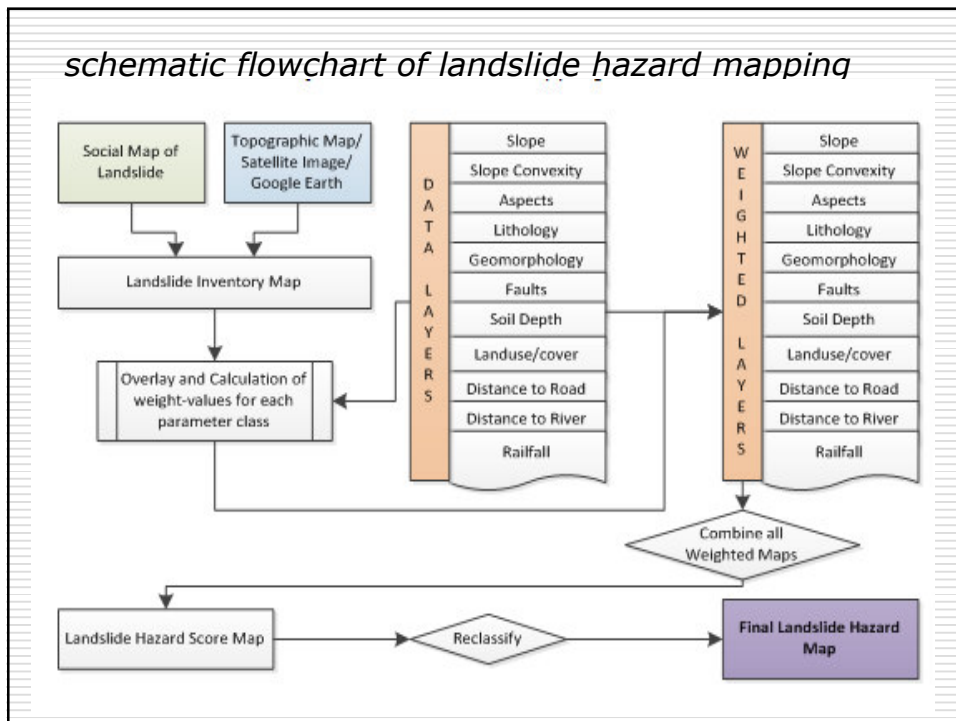
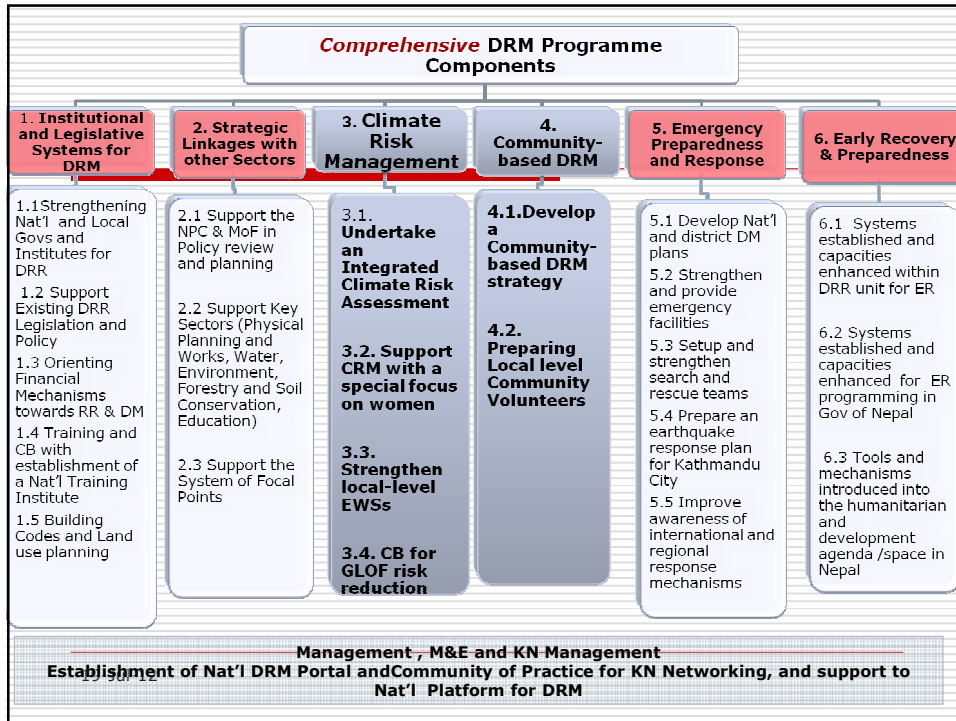
The five year CDRMP (2011-2015) aims to strengthen the institutional and legislative aspects of DRM in Nepal by building the capacities of key Government ministries, local bodies, academia, civil society, the private sector and communities.

The programme will also build partnerships with the existing national institutions to expand the institutional and knowledge base of DRM in Nepal.

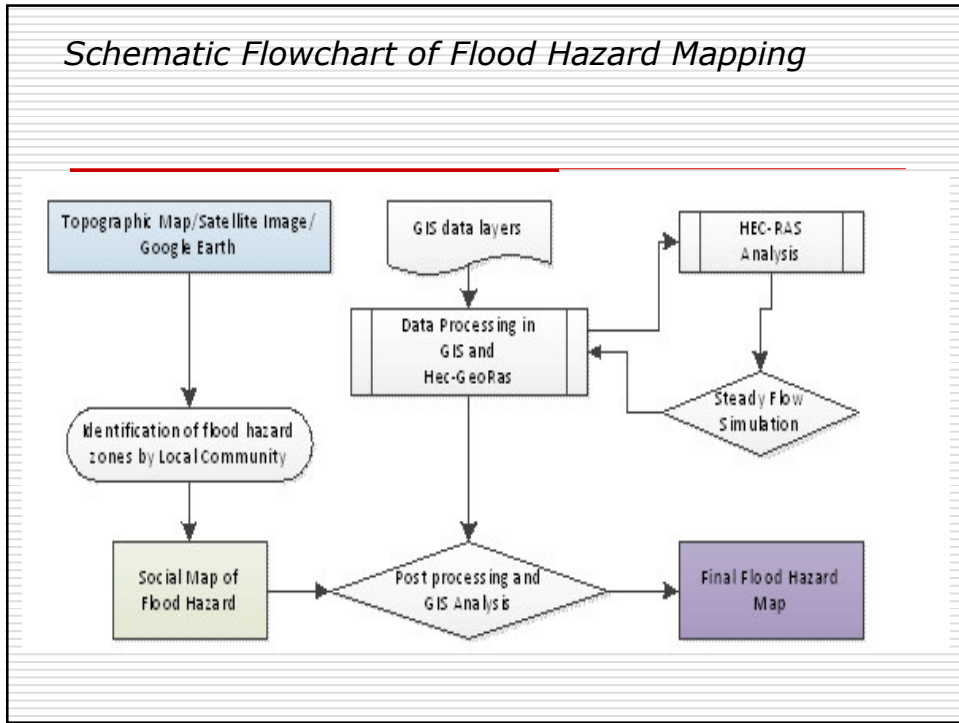
Objectives

- ❑ Reduce the physical vulnerability through support for application and enforcement of building codes and bylaws;
- ❑ Strengthen the overall system of DRM in Nepal through the intervention in the risk management, community based area of climate risk management, and emergency preparedness;
- ❑ Enhance partnerships with the Government, NGOs, academia, private sector and civil society and expand the institutional and knowledge base of DRM; and
- ❑ Support to establish strategic linkages between DRM and development sectors.

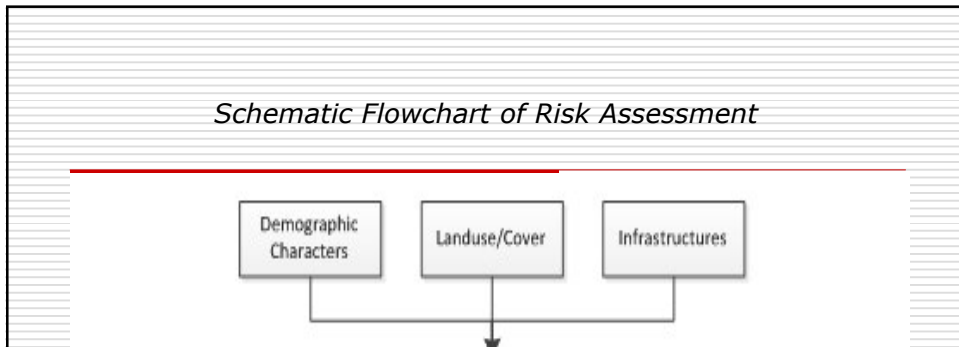
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Schematic Flowchart of Flood Hazard Mapping
