




Basic Obligation (I):

"Each Member shall set out in a schedule the specific commitments it undertakes under Part III of the Agreement." (Art. XX:1)

<u>Note</u>: Structure of schedules, number of commitments, sectors covered or levels of liberalization are not defined in GATS.

Scope and coverage of specific commitments

Article XVI (Market Access)

All measures, whether discriminatory or not, falling under one of six categories

Article XVII (National Treatment)

All (other) measures discriminating against services or service suppliers of any other Member.

Article XVIII (Additional Commitments) Non-discriminatory measures not falling under Article XVI or XVII.

How Schedules of Commitments

Modes of supply: 1) Cross-border supply 2) Consumption abroad 3) Commercial presence 4) Presence of natural persons

How to describe services sectors?

- There is no compulsory system
 - Members can use their own classification system
 - only requirement: greatest possible degree of clarity!
- There are two reference instruments:
 - Services Sectoral Classification List (W/120)
 - UN Central Product Classification List (CPC)
