

Identifying supply-side constraints to developing countries' agricultural trade: a progress report

The framework

- Identify the most important supply-side constraints to developing countries' agricultural trade
- Explore the contribution of A4T in supporting agricultural trade
- Follow up on to previous WPTC work on binding constraints to trade expansion
- Highlight links to poverty reduction and food security

Data and methodology

- Gravity framework - data on various types of supply-side constraints drawn from existing databases
- Taking into account specificities of agricultural trade in terms of tariffs and NTMs
- Factors impossible to cover due to data availability problems explored in case studies
- Targeting selected groups of countries, incl. landlocked, small and vulnerable, etc.

Variables of interest classified into :

➤ Comparative-advantage related variables

(land, machinery, water and other agricultural inputs; transport, telecommunications and electricity infrastructure; access to finance; business environment, etc.)

➤ Trade-cost related variables

(tariffs, non-tariff measures, trade facilitation)

➤ Variables describing other external factors
