- To make Bhutan as a green ICT investment hub












Broadband Information Highways

- National Fibre Optic network
 - Optical Ground Wire (OPGW)
 - to all 20 districts by June 2011
 - Adaptive Dielectric Self Supporting (ADSS)
 - to 142/205 Gewogs by 2012 (1280 kms)
 - Wireless
 - to connect remaining 63 Gewogs

OPGW, ADDS, Wireless













Cont...

- Community Centers (CCs)
 - 109 CCs by June 2011
 - 96 CCs by December 2011
 - 131 Learning Stations
 - Hole in the Wall e-Learning (HiWel) stations to be co-located with CCs
- Thimphu IT Park
 - Complete and Launch by June 2011
 - 2 data centres and 2 BPOs
 - 700 ICT graduates recruitment
 - − 10 − 15 years tax holidays
