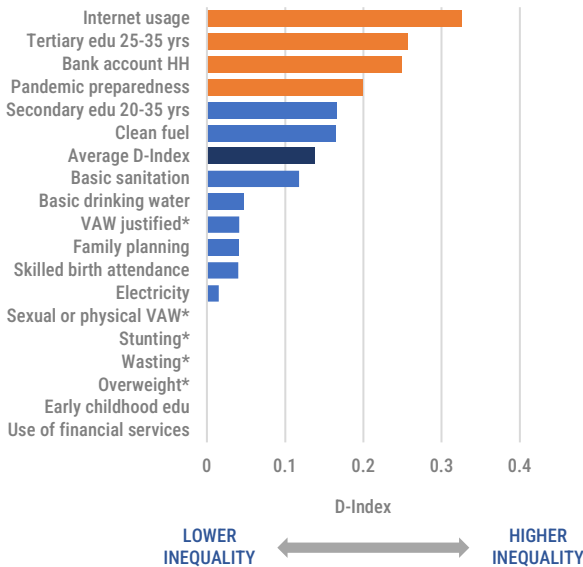

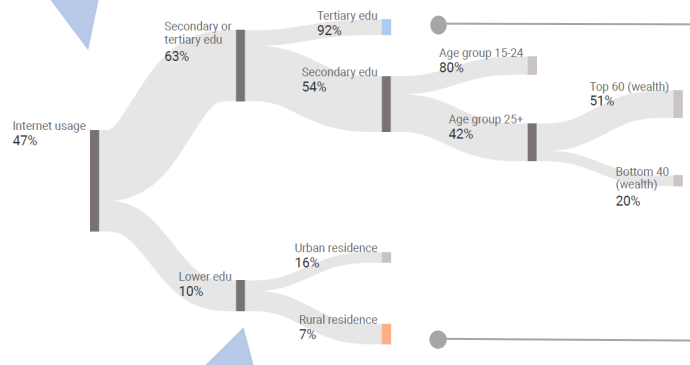


INTERNET USAGE
