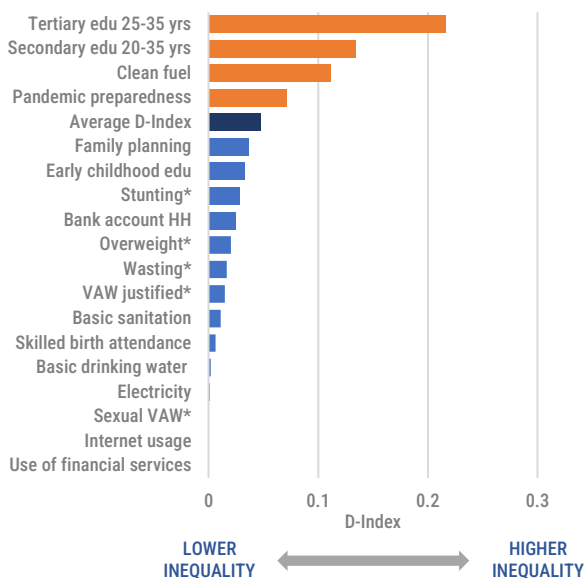

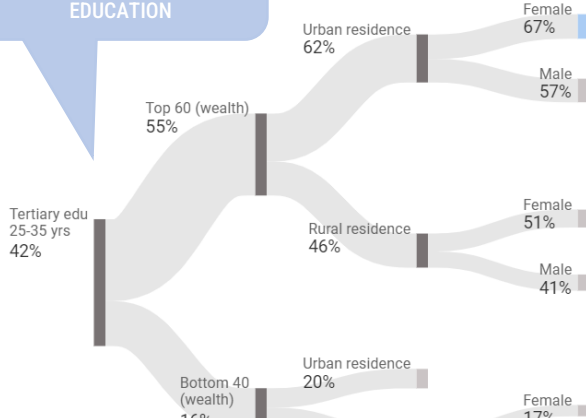


TERTIARY EDUCATION
