Meeting to Develop a Global Consensus on Preconception Care to Reduce Maternal and Childhood Mortality and Morbidity





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The meeting was organized by WHO Department of Maternal, Newborn, Child and Adolescent Health (MCA) in conjunction with the Aga Khan University, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the March of Dimes and the Preparing for Life Initiative.
