No. 6527. EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE NETHERLANDS AND CHILE CONCERNING THE ABOLITION OF THE TRAVEL VISA REQUIREMENT. SANTIAGO, 7 APRIL 1961

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to inform you that, with a view to promoting the development of tourist and trade relations between the Kingdom of the Netherlands and the Republic of Chile, and in order to harmonize the regulations affecting the movement of persons between the Benelux countries and Chile, I am instructed to propose that the agreement concerning passports set forth in the notes exchanged between our two Governments at Santiago de Chile on 18 June 1954² should be replaced by the following provisions :

1. Netherlands nationals holding a valid national passport may enter, stay in and travel in transit through Chile without the necessity of obtaining a visa.
2. Chilean nationals holding a valid national passport may enter, stay in and travel in transit through the Netherlands without the necessity of obtaining a visa.
3. Chilean nationals wishing to remain in the Netherlands for more than three months must apply to the competent Netherlands diplomatic or consular officer for a temporary residence permit and obtain it before departure.
4. The abolition of the travel visa requirement shall not exempt Netherlands and Chilean nationals visiting Chile and the Netherlands respectively from the necessity of complying with the laws and regulations concerning the entry and temporary or permanent residence of aliens and the carrying on by them of an independent or salaried gainful occupation.
5. It is understood that the abolition of the travel visa requirement also exempts the traveller from the necessity of obtaining an exit visa or of complying with any other formality for leaving either country.
