AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE AUSTRIAN FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND THE FEDERAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLY OF THE SOCIALIST FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA SUPPLEMENTING THE AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF AUSTRIA AND THE FEDERAL PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA, SIGNED ON THE ELEVENTH OF NOVEMBER 1953²

The Austrian Federal Government and the Federal Executive Council of the Assembly of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia,

Desiring to conclude an Agreement Supplementing the Air Services Agreement between the Republic of Austria and the Federal People's Republic of Yugoslavia, signed in Vienna on the Eleventh of November, 1953,² as amended by the exchange of notes of the Twenty-sixth of February, 1974³ and the Twenty-fourth of May, 1974,³ respectively,

Having taken into account the nature of the respective markets and the market access which each Contracting Party is prepared to make available to the other,

Wishing to assure an equitable exchange of opportunities for the designated airlines of each Contracting Party,

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

The Federal Executive Council of the Assembly of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia grants the designated airline of Austria the following rights in respect of the sale of scheduled air transportation in the territory of Yugoslavia:

1. The right to sell scheduled air transportation on all of its worldwide services directly through its own Representative Office(s) and, at its discretion, through Yugoslav agencies, to any person, organization or association, freely, for convertible currency using its own transportation documents, and to convert and transfer freely and promptly receipts from such sales to Austria.

2. The right to sell scheduled air transportation directly through its own Representative Office(s) and, at its discretion, through Yugoslav agencies, to any person, organization or association, for Yugoslav national currency using its own transportation documents for the following carriages:
 - (a) on the direct services operated by the designated airline of Austria between Yugoslavia and Austria and vice versa;
 - (b) on any services operated by the designated airline of Yugoslavia between Yugoslavia and Austria and within Yugoslavia where that transportation forms part of a journey between the two countries;
 - (c) on any services operated by the designated airline of Yugoslavia between Yugoslavia and points in Austria;
 - (d) on any services operated by the designated airline of Austria within Austria in connection with the transportation to/from Austria.

3. The right to sell scheduled air transportation directly through its own Representative Office(s) and, at its discretion, through Yugoslav agencies, to any person, organization or association, for Yugoslav national currency using the transportation documents of the designated airline of Yugoslavia for the following carriages:
 - (a) on the direct services operated by the designated airline of Austria between Yugoslavia and Austria and vice versa;
