AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDIA CONCERNING TECHNICAL COOPERATION IN SUPPORT OF THE PROJECT "PROMOTION OF EXPORTS"

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany
and
the Government of the Republic of India,

with reference to the Arrangement of 6/30 June 1988 and in pursuance of the Agreement of 31 December 1971 between the two Governments regarding Technical Cooperation, as amended by the Arrangement of 8 February/1 March 1979, have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Government of the Republic of India shall cooperate in a trade promotion programme involving integrated product and market development for the promotion of exports of specific products from India.

Article 2

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany shall make the following contributions to the project:

- (1) It shall
 - (a) second one expert in export promotion to coordinate the programme for 36 expert/months;

- (b) second, in the event that the programme is prolonged, a successor for the present coordinator to familiarize himself with the job six months prior to the expiry of the ongoing project phase;
 - (c) second to the Republic of India short-term experts in various specialities to assist selected Indian firms in product development and market promotion activities for a total of up to 200 expert/months;
 - (d) assign, in the Federal Republic of Germany, one expert in the promotion of exports to steer the project;
 - (e) assign local experts in the Republic of India for a total of up to 20 expert/months;
 - (f) assign up to eight local experts and diverse auxiliaries to the Delhi coordination office;
 - (g) assign experts for project evaluation for a total of up to 5 expert/months;
 - (h) supply one project vehicle, training material and other items of equipment, also for the coordination office.
- (2) It shall meet the cost of
- (a) accommodation for the seconded experts and their families, in so far as this cost is not borne by the seconded experts themselves;
