TOURISM COOPERATION AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES AND THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA

The Government of the United Mexican States and the Government of Jamaica (the Parties);

Desirous of strengthening the friendly relations existing between them;

Convinced that tourism, by virtue of its socio-cultural and economic dynamism, is an excellent instrument for promoting economic development, understanding and good will among the peoples;

Deciding to widen cooperation in the field of tourism and to make that cooperation as fruitful as possible

Have agreed to the following:

ARTICLE I

The Parties will grant the maximum facilities so that tourism promotion campaigns can be effected in their respective countries.

ARTICLE II

The Parties will exchange information on the domestic legislation of each country which regulates tourism and the admission in its territory of foreign tourists.
