BASIC AGREEMENT¹ ON TECHNICAL AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED MEXICAN STATES AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF BOLIVIA

The Government of the United Mexican States and the Government of the Republic of Bolivia, hereinafter referred to as “the Parties”,

Desiring to strengthen even further the traditional and friendly relations that exist between the two countries in the field of technical and scientific cooperation,

Convinced that such cooperation will prove mutually beneficial for the economic and social progress of their respective peoples,

Have agreed as follows:

Article I

The Parties shall jointly encourage and promote technical and scientific cooperation and shall develop integrated programmes and specific projects of mutual interest which shall be considered and implemented in accordance with their respective development policies.

Article II

The terms and conditions of scientific and technical cooperation shall be laid down in specific agreements and programmes. The latter may be concluded by any organization or institution so authorized by the respective Governments. Any revision and/or amendment thereof shall be drawn up in the manner in which it was established.

Article III

For the purposes of this Agreement, technical and scientific cooperation between the two countries may take the following forms:

1. Transfer of technological know how and expertise and provision of technical assistance,
2. Exchange of experts and advisers,
3. Training of human resources,
4. Exchange of documentation and information,
5. Exchange of materials and equipment,
6. Joint scientific and technological development projects,
7. Provision of fellowships for study and specialist training in the field of science and technology for intermediate-level professionals and technicians,
8. Organization of fairs, seminars, and conferences, and
