AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FRENCH REPUBLIC AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY CONCERNING THE GALATASARAY INSTITUTION OF INTEGRATED EDUCATION

Considering the Cultural Agreement of 17 June 1952;

Considering the Agreement on Technical and Scientific Cooperation of 29 October 1968² as well as the exchange of letters annexed thereto;

Desiring to strengthen their cooperation by specifying some of the details relating to the implementation of these Agreements;

Wishing in particular to expand their cooperation in the fields of primary education and higher education within the context of a French-language institution of integrated education established by the Turkish Government within the Lycée de Galatasaray;

Considering the desire of the Turkish Party to establish within such Institution a School of Law and Administration and a School of Advanced Technologies;

The Government of the French Republic and the Government of the Republic of Turkey have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Institution mentioned in the preamble shall be called the Galatasaray Institution of Integrated Education.

Instruction shall be offered from the primary through the post-secondary level. The Institution shall be jointly operated by the two Governments.

Article 2

The Institution shall have legal personality under Turkish public law. As such, it shall enjoy a special independent status as far as administrative and educational matters are concerned.

Article 3

The Institution shall be made up of the following educational, training and research units:

- The primary school, which is part of the Lycée,
- The Lycée, which is currently called the Lycée de Galatasaray,
- Units of higher education including the School of Law and Administration and the School of Advanced Technologies referred to in the preamble.
