EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS (UNITED NATIONS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION) AND THE GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN CONCERNING THE INTERREGIONAL PROJECT OF UNIDO FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT IN JAPAN OF THE UNIDO SERVICE FOR THE PROMOTION OF INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENT IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the recent discussions held between the representatives of the Government of Japan and the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (hereinafter referred to as “UNIDO”) concerning the inter-regional project of UNIDO for the establishment in Japan of a UNIDO Service for the Promotion of Industrial Investment in Developing Countries (hereinafter referred to as “the Service”) and to propose on behalf of the Government of Japan the following arrangements in respect of the afore-mentioned project:

1. The objective of the project is to strengthen the co-operation between Japan and the developing countries in the area of industrial co-operation, the promotion of investments projects and the related transfer of technology.

This objective will be furthered by close and trustful contacts between UNIDO as the UN Organization for the industrialization of developing countries and Japanese enterprises.

2. The duration of the project covered by the present arrangements shall be from July 1, 1980, to June 30, 1982.

3. The Government of Japan, subject to its budgetary appropriations, shall place at the disposal of UNIDO for the purpose of meeting the costs of the project as a special-purpose contribution to the United Nations Industrial Development Fund an amount up to the equivalent of three hundred thirty-two thousand six-hundred six US dollars (US\$ 332,606) in Japanese Yen. The costs in excess of the contribution provided by the Government of Japan shall be borne by UNIDO.

4. UNIDO shall administer the special-purpose contribution of the Government of Japan in accordance with its financial rules and other applicable regulations and shall make available a detailed list of vouchers on which payments were made and the relevant auditing report to the Government of Japan at its request.
