AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC  
OF KOREA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE MONGOLIAN  
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC CONCERNING THE MUTUAL ABOLI-  
TION OF VISAS ON DIPLOMATIC AND OFFICIAL PASSPORTS

The Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of  
the Mongolian People's Republic (hereinafter referred to as "the  
Contracting Parties"),

Desiring to further develop friendly relations and cooperation  
between their two countries:

Being resolved to facilitate official travel of their nationals  
between their two countries:

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

Nationals of the Republic of Korea and the Mongolian People's  
Republic, in possession of valid diplomatic or official passports,  
may enter the territory of the other country without a visa for a  
period of stay not exceeding thirty days from the date of their entry.

Article 2

Nationals of either country, in possession of passports referred  
to in Article 1, who are appointed to diplomatic or consular mission  
in the other country, and the members of their family forming part of  
their household, shall be permitted to enter without a visa the territory
