EXCHANGE OF NOTES CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARGENTINA FOR THE ISSUANCE OF MULTIPLE VISAS TO BUSINESSMEN

Your Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to the conversations which have recently taken place between the representatives of our two Governments regarding the issuance of multiple visas to businessmen, and to propose, on behalf of the Government of the Argentine Republic, to conclude an agreement on the following terms:

1. Businessmen of the Argentine Republic and the Republic of Korea who, holding a valid passport, intend to visit the other country for business purposes, shall be granted, at their request, multiple entry visas valid for three (3) years, and for a sojourn of thirty (30) days in each travel.
2. Argentine and Korean businessmen who apply for the visa mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall demonstrate to the consular authority of the other country their need to make frequent visits for commercial and economic purposes, and shall prove their status and representative capacity.
3. This Agreement shall remain in force until the sixtieth (60) day after the date on which either country notifies the other in writing of its intention to terminate this Agreement. The termination of this Agreement shall not affect those visas already granted.
