AGREEMENT¹ ON TOURISM COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

The Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of the Republic of India (hereinafter referred to as "the Contracting Parties"),

Striving to develop tourist relations between the two countries on the basis of equality and mutual benefit,

Desirous of more effective cooperation in the field of tourism on a bilateral basis,

Have agreed on the following:

ARTICLE 1

The Contracting Parties, recognising the differing background of tourism industry of the two countries, agree to share their experience and capabilities in a manner which would be of maximum mutual benefit. They shall identify specific areas of expertise where fruitful and mutually beneficial cooperation is possible.

ARTICLE 2

The Contracting Parties shall encourage cooperation in building and managing hotels and relevant facilities as these are regarded as central to the expansion of tourism in both countries.
