## AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> REGARDING TRADE IN AGRICULTURAL AND FISH PRODUCTS BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF SWEDEN AND THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania have, with reference to the Preamble, Article 2, and Article 7 of the Free Trade Agreement between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Lithuania signed on 17 March, 1992,<sup>2</sup> concluded the following Agreement regarding trade in agriculture and fish products:

### *Article 1*

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden shall grant tariff concessions to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania as specified in Annex I.

### *Article 2*

The Government of the Republic of Lithuania shall grant concessions to the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden as specified in Annex II.

### *Article 3*

The tariff concessions specified in the Annexes shall be applied from the date on which the Free Trade Agreement between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Republic of Lithuania enters into force.

### *Article 4*

The rules of origin for the application of this Agreement are set out in the Appendix to the Annexes.

### *Article 5*

The Government of the Kingdom of Sweden and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania shall ensure that the concessions granted are not compromised by other import measures. If difficulties related to prices or market access occur, consultations shall be held at the request of either Party as soon as possible with a view to agreeing on appropriate corrective action. In situations when difficulties relate to low prices due or partly due to export
