AGREEMENT¹ BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF ESTONIA AND THE
KINGDOM OF DENMARK ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF ECO-
NOMIC, INDUSTRIAL AND TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION

The Government of the Republic of Estonia and
the Government of the Kingdom of Denmark,
hereafter referred to as the Parties,

- desiring to make a new contribution to the
expansion and intensification of their mutu-
al economic relations on the basis of equal
rights and mutual advantage;
- wishing to make full use of the new possibi-
lities for the further strengthening of
their co-operation;
- recognizing in their mutual trade their re-
levant international obligations;
- emphasizing their desire to secure continui-
ty in Estonian-Danish cooperation, taking

into account the Agreement on the Establishment of a Joint Contact Group on Economic, Industrial and Technical Cooperation between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Tallinn (Estonia) and the Trade Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Copenhagen (Denmark) of November 26, 1990;

have agreed as follows.

Article 1

The Contracting Parties will seek to develop and encourage the economic, industrial and technical co-operation between interested institutions, organizations and enterprises in the two countries. This cooperation will take place in various sectors of the economy, as well as in the field of applied science and technology in the following fields of activity:

- a. co-operation on projects of common interest, including capital investment, license

- and know-how arrangements between Estonian and Danish enterprises and institutions in the two countries and on third markets,
- b. studies and visits, with a view to the implementation of common projects,
 - c. implementation of courses and conferences for specialists,
 - d. exchange of specialists and trainees,
 - e. exchange of technical documentation and information,
 - f. other mutually advantageous forms of co-operation.

Article 2

The parties shall actively assist in identifying areas and projects of particular importance to the development of democratic institutions and market economy in the Republic of Estonia. The implementation of such projects should take into account the experience of Danish public institutions and enterprises.

The Parties will seek to identify projects, which might be financed under existing bilateral and multilateral programmes of assistance.

Article 3

Taking into account the structure of the economies of the two countries, particularly promising areas of economic co-operation could be found within the sectors of industrial production, agriculture, food processing, forestry, fishery, energy, infrastructure, transport and logistics, communication, informatics, health, construction, consulting, services, tourism, development of the public sector, the financial sector, professional and vocational training of personnel, and protection of the environment.

Other sectors of mutual interest may be identified by the Parties.
