AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup> ON ECONOMIC, INDUSTRIAL, SCIENTIFIC AND  
TECHNOLOGICAL COOPERATION BETWEEN THE GOVERN-  
MENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND THE GOVERN-  
MENT OF IRELAND

The Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of Ireland  
(hereinafter referred to as "the Contracting Parties"),

Being desirous of further strengthening the friendly relations  
existing between the two countries and their peoples,

Recognizing the benefits to be derived by both countries from closer  
economic, industrial, scientific and technological cooperation,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

1. The Contracting Parties shall, in accordance with their international obligations and their respective laws and regulations, promote cooperation between the two countries in economic matters, and in the fields of industry and science and technology.
2. The Contracting Parties shall take all appropriate measures to encourage and facilitate economic, industrial, scientific and technological cooperation between governmental agencies, organizations and enterprises of the respective countries.

## Article 2

The Contracting Parties agree to:

- (a) examine the development of economic, industrial, scientific and technological cooperation between the two countries;
- (b) encourage arrangements for the further development of such cooperation and seek to identify new projects of cooperation in their respective countries and in third countries;
- (c) carry out reviews of the progress made in the fields of cooperation and make recommendations as to what action may be required in order to ensure that the objectives of this Agreement are achieved; and
- (d) consider any other matters arising from the implementation of this Agreement, which may be raised by either of the Contracting Parties.

## Article 3

The Contracting Parties shall attach great importance to strengthening cooperation in scientific and technological affairs, especially in connection with projects in which cooperation between companies and institutions of the two countries will be undertaken or enhanced.

## Article 4

The Contracting Parties shall encourage the development of scientific and technological cooperation, inter alia, through:

- (a) implementation of joint research projects on such fields as applied sciences and technologies;
- (b) exchange of research results, publications and information;
- (c) exchange of scientists, researchers, technical personnel, trainees and other experts; and
