THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF LESOTHO

PREAMBLE

The Government of the Kingdom of Lesotho and the Government of the Republic of South Africa (hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties" and in the singular as a "Party");

RECOGNIZING the historical links and geographic proximity that bind both countries;

ACKNOWLEDGING that neither country was able to develop its internal potential, nor foster sound bilateral relations until the demise of apartheid in the Republic of South Africa;

BEING MUTUALLY DESIROUS of consolidating and developing a special relationship, which will guide the strategic partnership and further intensify and enhance economic, social, good-governance, security and stability co-operation between the two countries;

GUIDED by the aspiration to strengthen and intensify friendly relations existing between their two countries and their peoples;

AWARE that the closer relationship among the peoples of both countries should find its expression in the facilitation of movement of people, goods and services;

CONSCIOUS of the necessity to promote security and cooperation in support of sustainable development in their respective

countries and on the African continent in general;

PROMPTED by their commitment to the universal norms of sovereign equality, democracy, human rights, co-operation for mutual benefit and the rule of law;

HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1 ESTABLISHMENT OF THE JOINT BILATERAL COMMISSION OF COOPERATION

The Parties hereby establish a Kingdom of Lesotho-Republic of South Africa Joint Bilateral Commission of Cooperation (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission").

ARTICLE 2 OBJECTIVES OF THE COMMISSION

The key objectives of the Commission are to-

- (1) guide the strategic partnership between the Parties;
- promote mutually beneficial economic integration between the two countries with the aim of closing the existing economic disparities;
- (3) promote cooperation in the field of science and technology with the aim of bridging the technological divide which exists between the two countries;

- (4) cultivate and promote good-governance, beneficial social, cultural, humanitarian and political co-operation and facilitate contact between the public and private sectors of the Parties;
- (5) maintain peace and security between the two countries and general stability in the Southern African region through collective action based on respect for democratic institutions, human rights and the rule of law;
- (6) co-operate and harmonize the position of the Parties in addressing multilateral issues of common interest;
- (7) facilitate movement of people, goods and services between their two countries taking into consideration the unique geographic position of Lesotho.

ARTICLE 3 COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION

The Commission shall be organized at the following levels:

- (a) Council of Ministers composed of Ministers of Foreign Affairs and other Ministers directly involved with the agenda at any given time;
- (b) Senior Government Officials composed of officials of Foreign Affairs as well as other Departments/ Ministries directly involved with the agenda at any given time.
