PREAMBLE

The Government of the Republic of South Africa and the Government of the Republic of Botswana (hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Parties" and in the singular as a "Party");

INSPIRED by a common desire to establish and develop closer cultural relations;

DESIROUS of promoting and developing in every possible manner the relations and understanding between South Africa and Botswana in the field of physical education and sports and recreation:

HEREBY AGREE as follows:

ARTICLE 1

The Parties shall facilitate and encourage cooperation in the fields of physical education, sports and recreation in order to contribute towards a better knowledge of their respective cultures and activities in these fields.

ARTICLE 2

The Parties shall encourage and facilitate -

- (a) reciprocal visits of experts in the areas covered by this Agreement for lectures, study tours, special courses and special meetings;
- (b) reciprocal visits of institutions, individuals and administrators involved in the areas covered by this Agreement;
- (c) participation in congress, conferences, symposia and seminars organized in the areas covered by this Agreement.
