DESIRING to conclude an Agreement for the purpose of establishing search and rescue services between and beyond their respective territories;

DEFINITIONS

In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise indicates -

"Agencies" means organisations, voluntary or otherwise, deployed to

support the search and rescue units during operations;

"Authorities" means competent authorities referred to in Article 2;

"Agreement" means this Agreement, any Annexures thereto, and any Amendments to the Agreement or any of its Annexures;

means the Convention of International Civil Aviation opened for signature at Chicago on the seventh day of December, 1944, and includes any Annexure adopted under any Article of the Convention and any amendments of the Annexure or the Convention under any Article in so far as those Annexures and amendments have been

adopted by both Parties;

"Rescue" means an operation to retrieve persons in distress, provide

for their initial medical or other needs, and deliver them

to a place of safety;

"Rescue Comeans a unit responsible for promoting efficient
ordination Centre
organisation of search and rescue services and for coordinating the conduct of search and rescue operations

within a search and rescue region;

"Rescue Submeans a unit subordinate to a Rescue co-ordination
centre, established to complement the RCC within a

specified portion of a search and rescue region;

"Search" means an operation normally coordinated by a rescue coordination centre or rescue sub-centre using available

personnel and facilities to locate persons in distress;

"Search and means an Aircraft normally provided with specialized equipment suitable for the efficient conduct of search and

rescue mission;

"Search and means an organisation established to organize and coordinate available resources so that effective and Organisation" expeditious search and/or rescue operations can be

assured.
