AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

AND

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA

CONCERNING BROADCASTING SERVICES TO WALVIS BAY

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the Government of the Republic of South Africa and the Government of the Republic of Namibia (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties") have agreed that Walvis Bay shall be transferred to/ reintegrated into Namibia with effect from 1 March 1994;

AND WHEREAS the Parties are committed to the resolution of all matters in connection therewith in such a way as to ensure a smooth transition and the continuation of existing services;

AND WHEREAS the South African Broadcasting Corporation has undertaken in the interests of the inhabitants of Walvis Bay to continue with its existing transmissions to Walvis Bay for a period until 30th June 1994;

AND WHEREAS in the furtherance of this goal the Parties consider it desirable to regulate certain matters relating to broadcasting in so far as they concern Walvis Bay;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1

In this Agreement -

"Sentech (Pty) Ltd" means the limited liability company registered under that name in the Republic of South Africa and wholly owned by the South African Broadcasting Corporation;
