AGREEMENT ON ECONOMIC AND
TECHNICAL COOPERATION BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC
OF KOREA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF
THE HASHEMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN

The Government of the Republic of Korea and the Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (hereinafter referred to as the "Contracting Parties"),

Recognizing the friendly relations already existing between their two countries and their peoples,

Desiring to strengthen and promote these relations, and

Realizing the common interests and benefits which would result from closer economic and technical cooperation,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Contracting Parties shall endeavour by all suitable means to promote and consolidate the economic and technical cooperation between their two countries in accordance with the laws and regulations applicable in the Republic of Korea and the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

Article 2

The two Parties shall encourage and support the development of their relations in the economic, technical and scientific potential of their national economies.

Article 3

The Contracting Parties shall take all possible and necessary measures to promote economic cooperation in various fields in the spirit of full understanding and mutual benefits. Such cooperation will be achieved through the enterprises and organizations of both countries.

Article 4

The Contracting Parties shall also take all possible and necessary measures to promote technical cooperation between both countries, especially through the exchange of trainees and technical experts as well as scientific and technical information in various fields.
