- (II) Transfer or permit any officer, employee, or agent of the Afghanistan Interim Administration to transfer such articles or related training including training materials or other defense services by gift, sale, or otherwise; or (III) use or permit the use of such articles or related training including training materials or defense services for purposes other than which provided;
- B. That said articles or related training including training materials or defense services shall be returned to the Government of the United States of America when they are no longer needed for the purposes for which they were furnished, unless the Government of the United States of America agrees to another disposition;
- C. That the net proceeds of sale received by the

 Afghanistan Interim Administration in disposing of, with

 prior written consent of the Government of the United

 States of America, any defense article furnished by the

 Government of the United States of America on a grant

 basis, shall be paid to the Government of the United States

 of America;
- D. That the Afghanistan Interim Administration shall maintain the security of such articles, related training including training materials, and other defense services; that it shall provide substantially the same degree of

security protection afforded to such articles or related

training including training materials or other defense services by the Government of the United States of America; that it shall, as the United States may require, permit continuous observation and review by, and furnish necessary information to, representatives of the Government of the United States of America with regard to the use thereof by the Afghanistan Interim Administration; and E. That the Government of the United States of America may also from time to time make the provision of articles, services, and related training furnished under other authority (except the United States Arms Export Control Act) subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement. (Transfers under the United States Arms Export Control Act shall continue to be governed by the requirements of that Act and United States regulations applicable to such transfers.)

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs' note stating that the foregoing is acceptable to the Afghanistan Interim

Administration shall, together with this note, constitute an agreement between the two governments, which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's reply.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of
