[ENGLISH TEXT – TEXTE ANGLAIS]

New Delhi, May 15, 1959

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement on the Canada-India Colombo Plan Kundah Hydro-electric Power Project signed at New Delhi on the 29th day of December 1956.

In order that the Agreement may provide for the construction of a transmission line to link the Kundah hydro-electric development with the electricity distribution system of the State of Madras, I have the honour, on behalf of the Government of Canada, to propose the following amendments to the Agreement and Annex:

- (a) in Article II of the Agreement the total Canadian contribution shall be increased from \$20 million to \$25 million;
- (b) paragraph 20 of the Annex referred to in Article V of the Agreement shall be amended to read as follows: "Subject to the limitation on the total Canadian contribution specified in Article II of the Agreement, as amended, the Government of Canada will supply the following sub-station and transmission equipment for the 230 KV single circuit line from Kundah power house number 2 to Villivakkam via Salem, including step down facilities to 110 KV at Kundah power house number 2, Salem and Villivakkam, and for the 110 KV double circuit line from Kundah power house number 1 to Kundah power house number 2 and from Kundah power house number 2 to Tudiyalur:
 - (a) towers
 - (b) tower line hardware
 - (c) insulators
 - (d) conductors
 - (e) ground wires and accessories
 - (f) carrier current equipment for communication and relaying
 - (g) step down transformers for Salem and Villivakkem
 - (h) outdoor switchgear and structures for Tudiyalur, Salem and Villivakkem
 - (i) power and control cables for Tudiyalur, Salem and Villivakkem
 - (j) indoor switchgear including relaying for the same three sub-stations
 - (k) 1-25 MVA synchronous condenser for voltage control at Villivakkem

If these amendments are acceptable to the Government of India, I have the honour to suggest that this note and your affirmative reply shall constitute an agreement between our Governments, a ending the agreement on the Canada-India Colombo Plan Kundah Hydro-electric power project signed at New Delhi on the 29th day of December 1956, which will take effect upon the date of your reply.

Accept, sir, the renewed assurance of my highest consideration.
