**AGREEMENT**  
**BETWEEN**  
**THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA**  
**AND**  
**THE GOVERNMENT OF BARBADOS**  
**ON AIR TRANSPORT**

**THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF BARBADOS**  
hereinafter referred to as the "Contracting Parties";

**BEING** parties to the *Convention on International Civil Aviation*, done at Chicago  
on 7 December 1944;

**DESIRING** to ensure the highest degree of safety and security in international air  
transportation;

**RECOGNIZING** the importance of international air transportation in promoting trade,  
tourism and investment;

**DESIRING** to promote their interests in respect of international air transportation; and

**DESIRING** to conclude an agreement on air transport, supplementary to the Convention;

**HAVE AGREED** as follows:

**ARTICLE 1**

**Headings and Definitions**

1. The headings used in this Agreement are for reference purposes only.
2. For the purpose of this Agreement, unless otherwise stated:
  - (a) “aeronautical authorities” means, in the case of Barbados, the Minister responsible for Civil Aviation and in the case of Canada, the Minister of Transport and the Canadian Transportation Agency or, in both cases, any other entity or person empowered to perform the functions exercised by those authorities;
  - (b) “agreed services” means scheduled air services on the routes specified in this Agreement for the transport of passengers and cargo, including mail, separately or in combination;
  - (c) “Agreement” means this Agreement, its Annexes, and any amendment to this Agreement or its Annexes;
  - (d) “air service”, “international air service” and “airline” have the meanings respectively assigned to them in Article 96 of the Convention;
  - (e) “Convention” means the *Convention on International Civil Aviation*, done at Chicago on 7 December 1944 and includes any Annex adopted under Article 90 of that Convention and any amendment of the Convention or of the Annexes under Articles 90 and 94 adopted by both Contracting Parties;
  - (f) “designated airline” means an airline which has been designated and authorized in accordance with Articles 3 and 4;
