AGREEMENT OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE CUSTOMS UNION ON THE REMOVAL OF TECHNICAL BARRIERS TO MUTUAL TRADE WITH STATES MEMBERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF INDEPENDENT STATES THAT ARE NOT MEMBER STATES OF THE CUSTOMS UNION

The Republic of Belarus, the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Russian Federation, hereinafter referred to as the Parties,

With a view to expanding mutual trade among member States of the Customs Union and the States members of the Commonwealth of Independent States that are not members of the Customs Union,

Bearing in mind the rules and principles set out in the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade and the Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures of the World Trade Organization, adopted on 15 April 1994 as an outcome of the Uruguay Round of multilateral trade negotiations, and also the provisions of the Agreement on the Application of a Coordinated Policy in the Field of Standardization, Metrology and Certification of 13 March 1992, the Agreement on a Framework for Harmonizing the Technical Regulations of the States Members of the Eurasian Economic Community of 24 March 2005, the Agreement on the Application of a Coordinated Policy in the Field of Technical Regulation and Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures of 25 January 2008, the Customs Union Agreement on Sanitation of 11 December 2009, the Customs Union Agreement on Plant Quarantine of 11 December 2009, the Agreement on Common Principles and Rules of Technical Regulation in the Republic of Belarus, the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Russian Federation of 18 November 2010 and the Treaty on the Eurasian Economic Commission of 18 November 2011,

Wishing to remove technical barriers to mutual trade with States members of the Commonwealth of Independent States that are not member States of the Customs Union,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

In the present Agreement, technical barriers to trade shall be understood to mean differences in the requirements of national technical regulations, standards and conformity assessment (validation) procedures of a State member of the Commonwealth of Independent States that is not a member State of the Customs Union, and of the technical regulations of the Customs Union, of the standards applied in the Customs Union and of the conformity assessment (validation) procedures of the Customs Union pertaining to similarly named products, resulting in barriers to mutual trade.

Other concepts used in the present Agreement shall be employed in the meaning defined by the Agreement on the Application of a Coordinated Policy in the Field of Technical Regulation and Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures of 25 January 2008, the Customs Union Agreement on Sanitary Measures of 11 December 2009, and the Agreement on Common Principles and Rules of Technical Regulation in the Republic of Belarus, the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Russian Federation of 18 November 2010.
